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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING UNIQUELY IDENTIFYING STUDENT NUMBERS FOR**  
102 **PERSONS ENROLLED IN ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS.**

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**Bill Summary**

**Educational Success Task Force.** The bill requires the commissioner of education to assign a unique student identifier for each person enrolled in an adult basic education program, family literacy program, or high school equivalency certificate (GED) program, if the person has not previously been assigned a state-assigned student identifier

in Colorado. Each local education provider shall report to the department of education (department) the state-assigned student identifier for each student enrolled in a family literacy program. The department shall retain records of the state-assigned student identifiers for persons enrolled in adult basic education, family literacy, or GED programs.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-124, **add** (7) (d)  
3 as follows:

4           **22-2-124. Family literacy education grant program - rules.**  
5 (7) (d) EACH LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER SHALL REPORT TO THE  
6 DEPARTMENT THE STATE-ASSIGNED STUDENT IDENTIFIER FOR EACH  
7 STUDENT ENROLLED IN A FAMILY LITERACY EDUCATION PROGRAM. THE  
8 DEPARTMENT SHALL ASSIGN A UNIQUELY IDENTIFYING STUDENT NUMBER  
9 TO EACH PERSON ENROLLED IN A FAMILY LITERACY EDUCATION PROGRAM  
10 WHO HAS NOT PREVIOUSLY BEEN ASSIGNED A STATE-ASSIGNED STUDENT  
11 IDENTIFIER IN COLORADO.

12           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-112, **add** (1) (p)  
13 as follows:

14           **22-2-112. Commissioner - duties.** (1) Subject to the supervision  
15 of the state board, the commissioner has the following duties:

16           (p) TO ASSIGN A UNIQUELY IDENTIFYING STUDENT NUMBER TO  
17 EACH PERSON ENROLLED IN AN ADULT BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM, A  
18 FAMILY LITERACY PROGRAM, OR A HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY  
19 CERTIFICATE PROGRAM WHO HAS NOT PREVIOUSLY BEEN ASSIGNED A  
20 STATE-ASSIGNED STUDENT IDENTIFIER IN COLORADO. THE DEPARTMENT  
21 SHALL RETAIN RECORDS OF THE STATE-ASSIGNED STUDENT IDENTIFIERS  
22 FOR PERSONS ENROLLED IN THESE PROGRAMS.
