


# Town of Milliken 2013 Flood

# Event - Crisis

- 15" Rain within 48 hours in River Basins
- Little Thompson River, Big Thompson River and South Platte River above flood stage
- Irrigation Systems saturated
- Regional flow

- 35 Red Tags
- 8 Yellow Tags
- Evacuations
- Sheltering 200+




# Impact to Roads

- Structural assessment




# Road closure




# Impact to Industrial Properties

- Swollen systems cannot hold flood waters
- Planning for Spring 2014 – Spring run-off and clear delivery system




# Long Term Recovery: November and well into 2014
