CRIMINAL CODE — UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT OF 1992

Offenses Related to the Uniform Controlled Substances Act of 1992

- Offenses relating to marijuana and marijuana concentrate.** Any person who possesses not more than two ounces of marijuana commits a drug petty offense.

Any person who openly and publicly displays, consumes, or uses two ounces or less of marijuana commits a drug petty offense.

Any person who transfers or dispenses two ounces or less of marijuana for no consideration commits a drug petty offense.
- Authorized possession of controlled substances.** Any person who possesses a prescribed controlled substances in a container other than that in which it was dispensed and who is unable to show legal ownership commits a drug petty offense.
- Possession of drug paraphernalia.** Any person who possesses drug paraphernalia and who knows or reasonably should know that the paraphernalia could be used under circumstances in violation of the laws of this state commits a drug petty offense.
