101 **CONCERNING OPTIONAL AFFILIATION WITH THE FIRE AND POLICE**
102 **PENSION ASSOCIATION BY A COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT**
103 **THAT DOES NOT PARTICIPATE IN SOCIAL SECURITY.**

association (FPPA). The bill allows sheriff departments that do not participate in social security to participate in the FPPA.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 31-31-708 as
3 follows:

4 **31-31-708. Optional affiliation by county sheriff.** ANY COUNTY
5 THAT DOES NOT COVER, UNDER THE FEDERAL "SOCIAL SECURITY ACT", AS
6 AMENDED, SALARIED EMPLOYEES WHOSE DUTIES ARE DIRECTLY
7 INVOLVED WITH THE PROVISION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OR FIRE
8 PROTECTION AS CERTIFIED BY THE COUNTY MAY ELECT COVERAGE UNDER
9 THE STATEWIDE DEFINED BENEFIT PLAN ESTABLISHED IN PART 4 OF THIS
10 ARTICLE AND THE STATEWIDE DEATH AND DISABILITY PLAN ESTABLISHED
11 IN PART 8 OF THIS ARTICLE BY FILING A RESOLUTION OF AFFILIATION WITH
12 THE BOARD. ELECTION OF COVERAGE UNDER THE PLAN IS IRREVOCABLE.

13 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly
16 (August 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except
17 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
18 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
19 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
20 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
21 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
22 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
