BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES

The Orchard Mesa Sanitation District Board of Directors held its regularly scheduled meeting on November 3, 2015. The meeting was located at the District's office, 240 27-1/4 Road, Grand Junction, CO. The following Board members were in attendance: Christi Elsberry, Heather Gross, Melody Sebesta and Steve Jennings. Ron Elsberry attended the meeting via conferencing call. Also, attending the meeting was Deborah D. Heidel-Davis, District Manager.

The meeting was called to order and the following business was conducted:

The minutes of the October 20, 2015 Board of Directors meeting were reviewed. It was the unanimous consensus of the Board to approve the minutes.

General Business:

1.) District Dissolution Process:

Board and staff discussed the Public Hearing" held by the District on October 26, 2015, regarding the dissolution of the District at the end of 2016. The hearing was held at the Mesa County Fairgrounds at 7:00 p.m.

2.) Financial Issues:

a.) Accounts Payable for November 3, 2015:

Board and staff reviewed the Accounts Payable for November 3, 2015. Christi Elsberry made a motion that the Board approves payment of the payables. Steve Jennings seconded the motion and it was approved by unanimous vote of the Board.

b.) City Rate Increase:

Ms. Heidel-Davis informed the Board that she received a call from the City regarding the City's rate increase. The City was unable to give an actual set amount. The City is estimating that the increase will be \$1.00 +/- . The District will not have an actual figure until late November.

c.) Preliminary Budget 2016:

The Board was informed that the 2016 proposed budget will be revised again due to the change in the City of Grand Junction's rate increase. A revised budget will be given at the next Board meeting.

Other Business:

1.) QB Purchase:

Board and the Manager discussed the purchase of the QK training modulars at the school for a special in-class rate. It was the consensus of the Board to approve the purchase.
