

ORDINANCE NO. 1988-2

TITLE AND PURPOSE:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF, ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1985 EDITION, OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO, IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF SAID BUILDING CODE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara has made a thorough study of the 1985 Edition of the Uniform Building Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is of the opinion that the same should be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption. -- Pursuant to Title 31, Article 16, Parts 1 and 2, Colo. Rev. Stat. 1973, as amended, there is hereby adopted as the Building Code of the Town of La Jara, by reference thereto, the Uniform Building Code, 1985 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601, to have the same force and effect as if set forth herein in every particular. The subject matter of the adopted code includes comprehensive provisions and standards regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alterations, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance of buildings and structures for the purpose of protecting the public health, safety, and general welfare.

Section 2. Amendments and Deletions.

a. Section 204 -- Board of Appeals -- of Chapter 2 of the above-cited code is hereby amended, and as amended, reads as follows:

"BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS

Section 204. In order to determine the suitability of alternate materials and methods of construction and to provide for reasonable interpretations of this code, and for the purpose of hearing appeals with respect thereto, the Board of Adjustments of the Town of La Jara shall pass upon matters pertaining to building construction and shall hear all appeals with respect thereto. The La Jara Building Inspector shall be an ex-officio member of said Board. The Board of Adjustments shall adopt rules of procedure for conducting its business with respect to the enforcement and interpretation of the Building Code, and appeals with respect thereto, and shall render all decisions and findings in writing to the appellant with a duplicate copy to the La Jara Building Inspector."

b. Subsection (b) of Section 301 of Chapter 3 is amended by the addition of new subparagraph 12, said new subparagraph 12 reading as follows:

"12. Roofing Repair and Maintenance"

c. Table 3-A of chapter 3 of the above-cited Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following table:

\$2,001.00 to \$25,000.00	\$20.00 for the first \$2,000.00 plus \$3.00 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof, to and including \$25,000.00
\$25,001.00 to \$50,000.00	\$89.00 for the first \$25,000.00 plus \$2.50 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof, to and including \$50,000
\$50,001.00 to \$100,000.00	\$151.50 for the first \$50,000.00 plus \$1.50 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof, to and including \$100,000.00
\$100,001.00 and up	\$226.50 for the first \$100,000.00 plus \$1.50 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof

d. Chapter 70 -- Excavation and Grading -- of the above-cited Code is deleted in its entirety.

Section 3. Code Copies. -- At least three (3) copies of the Uniform Building Code, 1985 Edition, of the International Conference of Building Officials, certified to be true copies, have been and now are on file in the office of the Town Clerk, and may be inspected by any interested person between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excepted. The "Building Code", if finally adopted, shall be available for sale to the public through the office of the Town Clerk at a moderate price.

Section 4. Penalties.

a. The following penalty clause, contained in the Uniform Building Code, is herewith set in full and adopted

"Section 205. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to erect, construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, improve, remove, convert or demolish, equip, use, occupy, or maintain any building or structure, or cause or permit the same to be done in violation of this Code."

b. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Code shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and each such person shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each and every day or portion thereof during which any violation of any of the provisions of this Code is committed, continued, or permitted, and upon conviction of any such violation, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. Savings Clause. -- If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance or of the Building Code adopted hereby is for any reason held to be invalid, such decisions, shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Ordinance or of said Building Code; the Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and adopted said Building Code in each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid.

Section 6. Repeal. -- Any or all ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of La Jara, in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the repeal of any ordinance or parts of ordinances of the Town of La Jara shall not revive any other sections of any ordinance or ordinances heretofore repealed or superseded. Ordinance No. 1975-4, "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF, ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1973 EDITION, OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO, IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HERewith; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF SAID BUILDING CODE", and Ordinance No. 1979-7, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1975-4", are hereby specifically repealed in their entirety.

Section 7. Publication. -- The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance, cause notice of its contents and passage to be published or posted, and make not less than three (3) copies of the adopted Uniform Building Code 1985 Edition, available for the inspection by the public during regular business hours.

Section 8. Effective Date. -- Whereas, an emergency exists in that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and publication.
