
1. Order Granting Complainant's Motions for Partial Summary Judgment; Order of Dismissal



In addition to serving the State Personnel Board with a copy of the Notice of Appeal, the party filing the appeal with the Court of Appeals must name the State Personnel Board as a party (appellee) to the appeal. Section 24-4-106(11)(d), C.R.S.
