**ORDER OF THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD REGARDING PETITION FOR

This matter is before the Colorado State Personnel Board (the "Board") at its regularly scheduled public session held on January 20, 2009. During this public session, the Board reviewed the January 8, 2009 Petition for Declaratory Order of Petitioner Rich Gonzales, State Personnel Director. Based on the Board's review, and the presentation from Mr. Gonzales and others at the meeting,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to Board Rule 8-21, the Petition for Declaratory Order is granted and the Board orders the matter set for briefing, as described below, on the issues set forth in the Petition, and the parties are also directed to address the matters outlined in Board Rule 8-21(B), in particular the issue of ripeness.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that additional parties in interest in this matter are hereby designated as Colorado WINS and the Association of Colorado State Patrol Professionals.

Briefing Schedule:

Opening briefs of both the petitioner and the parties in interest are to be filed with the Board and served on the respective parties, by facsimile and United States postal service, no later than **January 30, 2009**.


Any answer or response briefs are to be filed with the Board and served on the parties no later than **February 9, 2009**.

Briefs are to be typewritten with the text double spaced. No opening brief shall exceed 15 pages in length. No response brief shall exceed 10 pages in length. Only 8 1/2 x 11 inch paper shall be used. An **original and 9 copies** of each brief must be filed with the Board.

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board in February is rescheduled to **Tuesday, February 24, 2009**, to be held at the **State Personnel Board, 633 17th Street, Suite 1400, Courtroom 1, Denver Colorado 80202-3604**, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The Board

will take up the Petition and briefs at the conclusion of its regularly scheduled meeting. The parties need not be present at this Board meeting.
