

## **Voting Precincts Modifications to Reapportionment Database Voting Precinct File**

The Legislative Council staff has modified the geographic data provided in the US Census Bureau TIGER files depicting voting precincts in Colorado for use by the Colorado Reapportionment Commission in state legislative redistricting and by the Colorado General Assembly in congressional redistricting. Under section 1-5-101 (5), C.R.S., counties were not allowed to redraw or create new precincts after the precincts were established for the 2008 election unless a county split an existing precinct into smaller parts. The changes made to the geographic data included the addition of 34 new precincts in four counties where existing precincts were split, Denver (3), Douglas (9), El Paso (16), and Weld (6).

The precincts that were split are:

Denver - 16735, 16737, 16743;

Douglas -18134, 18054, 18088, 18118, 18008, 18002, 18050, 18103, 18049;

El Paso - 21077, 21158, 21181, 21289, 21300, 21325, 21332, 21334, 21335, 21364, 21368, 21374, 21376, 21377, 21378, 21379;

Weld - 62117, 62200, 62228, 62232, 62307, 62330.

The new precinct numbers are:

Denver – 16748, 16749, 16750;

Douglas -18139, 18140, 18141, 18142, 18143, 18144, 18145, 18146, 18147;

El Paso – 21388, 21389, 21390, 21391, 21392, 21393, 21394, 21395, 21396, 21397, 21398, 21399, 21400, 21401, 21402, 21404;

and Weld – 62138, 62245, 62246, 62247, 62335, 62336.
