



New and Retired Measures

- *New measure: Non-Recommended Cervical Cancer Screening in Adolescent Females*
- No measures were retired for HEDIS 2014

Other Changes

- Code tables are removed from the measure specifications and included in the Volume 2 Value Set Directory.
- Medication tables remain in the specifications and table names are unchanged in order to minimize the number of changes throughout the publication. Therefore, table names may not be sequential.
- Cervical Cancer Screening has significant changes; NCQA will not publicly report for HEDIS 2014 (measure will be treated like a first year measure).

Other Changes

HEDIS Audit Timeline Task	NCQA Deadline
Organization submits the completed current year's Roadmap to the auditor.	January 31
Auditor receives software vendor's final certification report and measure identifiers, or organization submits completed source code for auditor review (for noncertified code).	March 3
Auditor finalizes approval of supplemental data, policies, procedures and content (data). All supplemental data collection and entry ends.	March 3
Onsite visits completed.	April 30
Preliminary rate review and feedback completed.	May 5
Organization completes the medical record abstraction process for all measures; sends final numerator-compliant counts for all measures; sends exclusions and numerator-compliant lists for selected measures to the auditor for MRRV.	May 15
Organization submits the auditor-locked IDSS submission, with attestation, to NCQA.	June 16
