Medicaid & CHP+ Enrollment

- 1,047,466 Coloradans enrolled in Medicaid (June 2014)
- 57,673 Coloradans enrolled in Child Health Plan *Plus* (June 2014)

2015 Open Enrollment

- November 15, 2014—February 15, 2015
- You can apply for Medicaid and CHP+ at any time!
- What we are working on:
 - Developing a shared eligibility system with Connect for Health Colorado—helping to improve the consumer experience
 - Updating the look and feel of the Medical Assistance application on Colorado.gov/PEAK
 - Incorporating consumer testing and stakeholder feedback in to Medical Assistance application
 - Developing joint training content with Connect for Health Colorado, HCPF and PEAK Outreach



Adult Dental Benefit

- Now adults with Medicaid will have access to dental services.
- The new benefit will an annual dental benefit of up to \$1,000 per state fiscal year.
- The benefit include:
 - Basic adult dental preventive.
 - Comprehensive adult services such as root canals, crowns, partial dentures, etc.
 - Other procedures requiring prior authorization will also be available.



Online Plan and Provider Selection

- **New** Colorado Medicaid members can now select their Medicaid health plan and provider through *HealthColorado* online
- This online option can be only be used by new Colorado Medicaid members; current members must call *HealthColorado*

Who Qualifies?

The program serves students who are:

- On Medicaid
- In a public school or participating district
- Under the age of 21
- Disabled, medically at risk and receiving or referred for services according to an Individualized Education Program
