

# Forest View Acres Yearly Summary Report 2014

## January

- SWTP produced the majority of demand.

## February

- Working with JDS to install 3" service line to AWP for future use in backwashing the filters.

## March

- SWTP running continuously amidst higher spring runoff turbidities.
- SWTP providing for 100% of demand.
- Backwash accounts for 10% of all water made from SWTP.

## April

- One pneumatic valve was rebuilt at the AWP.
- SWTP production declines due to spring runoff and higher turbidities.
- SWTP still runs consistently but backwashes more frequently.

## May

- Booster pump failed to run at booster station resulting in approximately 600,000 gallons lost.

## June

- Inlet box filled with sand, limited flow production at SWTP.
- Water main break at 4730 Sandstone
- Water main break at 18509 Pike View Way
- Water main break at 4730 Red Forest Rd
- Water main break at 18650 Clovenhoof

## July

- A leak was repaired at 3815 Sierra Vista.

## August

- Fire mitigation on the SWTP grounds was completed.
- Cleaned gravel and sand from inlet box to restore flows to SWTP.

## September

- Online chlorine and turbidity instruments had annual service performed.
- Two water main breaks at Sierra Vista where dirt begins
- Leak at abandoned saddle tap for 18235 Sunburst.
- Leak in PRV pit #5.

## October

- Temporary recycle pump system was started at the SWTP during backwash pond renovations.

## November

- Hydrant on Pixie Park south of Limestone (PPHY2) failed to close and was deemed inoperable.

## December

- Water main break in 4" PVC west of SWTP to tank.
- Leak on Pike View way fixed.
- Backwash pond modification complete.
