BILL REQUESTS AND GENERAL SESSION DEADLINE FOR:

<i>December 2, 2013 (Monday)</i>	Members to request bills. Members may not introduce more than five bills. Of the five bills, excluding appropriations and interim bills, not more than two bills may be requested after December 1.	Pre-session
<i>January 3 (Friday)</i>	Filing one of each member's three bills requested prior to December 1 with the house of introduction for printing, distribution to Legislative Council Staff for preparation of fiscal notes, and introduction on the 1st day.	Pre-session
<i>January 8 (Wednesday)</i> General Assembly Convenes	Introducing bills required to be filed 5 days prior to the 1st day and bills to increase the number of judges .	1st Day
<i>January 10 (Friday)</i>	Introducing the two remaining Senate bills requested prior to December 1.	3rd Day
<i>January 14 (Tuesday)</i>	Introducing the two remaining House bills requested prior to December 1 and for submitting remaining bill requests to the Office of Legislative Legal Services.	7th Day
<i>January 24 (Friday)</i>	Introducing Senate bills , except for supplemental appropriation bills recommended by the Joint Budget Committee and the Long Bill.	17th Day
<i>January 29 (Wednesday)</i>	Introducing House bills , except for supplemental appropriation bills recommended by the Joint Budget Committee and the Long Bill.	22nd Day
<i>February 3 (Monday)</i>	Introducing supplemental appropriation bills recommended by the Joint Budget Committee.	27th Day
<i>February 26 (Wednesday)</i>	Final passage of Senate bills in the Senate and House bills in the House.**	50th Day
<i>March 7 (Friday)</i>	Final passage of any bill that increases the number of judges .	59th Day
<i>March 24 (Monday)</i>	Introducing the Long Bill in the House.	76th Day
<i>March 28 (Friday)</i>	Final passage of the Long Bill in the House.	80th Day
<i>March 31 (Monday)</i>	Final passage in the Senate of House bills .**	83rd Day
<i>April 4 (Friday)</i>	Final passage of the Long Bill in the Senate.	87th Day
<i>April 7 (Monday)</i>	Final passage in the House of all Senate bills .**	90th Day
<i>April 11 (Friday)</i>	Adoption of the conference committee report on the Long Bill .	94th Day
<i>April 14 (Friday)</i>	Requesting resolutions subject to the introduction deadline on the 100th day.	97th Day
<i>April 17 (Thursday)</i>	Introducing resolutions and bills.	100th Day
<i>April 18 (Friday)</i>	Final passage in house of introduction of all bills referred to the Appropriations Committee in that house. Final passage, including any conference committee report, for any school finance bills.	101st Day
<i>May 1 (Thursday)</i>	Final passage in second house of all bills referred to Appropriations Committee in that house.	114th Day
<i>May 5 (Monday)</i>	Reconvene for adjournment sine die if there has been adjournment to a day certain, unless the joint resolution for adjournment to a day certain specifies another day for reconvening.	118th Day
<i>May 7 (Wednesday)</i>	Adjournment sine die.	120th Day

COMMITTEES, DEADLINE FOR:

<i>January 7 (Tuesday)</i>	Joint committees to meet with state departments to review strategic plans and regulatory agendas. The meeting are to occur between November 1 and the start of the session.	Pre-session
<i>February 5 (Wednesday)</i>	Committees to meet with the Joint Budget Committee to review department budget priorities.	29th Day
<i>February 6 (Thursday)</i>	House committees to report House bills introduced on or before the 7th legislative day, other than the House Appropriations Committee.	30th Day
<i>February 13 (Thursday)</i>	Senate committees to report Senate bills, other than the Senate Appropriations Committee.	37th Day
<i>February 20 (Thursday)</i>	House committees to report remaining House bills, other than the House Appropriations Committee.	44th Day
<i>March 21 (Friday)</i>	Committees to report bills originating in the other house, other than the Appropriations Committees.	73rd Day
<i>April 11 (Friday)</i>	Appropriations Committee in house of introduction to report referred bills.	94th Day
<i>April 24 (Thursday)</i>	Committees in the second house to report bills referred to the Appropriations Committee in that house.	107th Day
<i>April 28 (Monday)</i>	Appropriations Committee in second house to report bills.	111th Day

INTERIM STUDIES, DEADLINE FOR:

<i>April 11 (Friday)</i>	Deadline to submit written requests to the Legislative Council for interim studies.	94th Day
<i>April 17 (Thursday)</i>	Deadline for the Legislative Council Director of Research to submit to the Legislative Council Executive Committee the number of interim committee meetings that may be held.	100th Day
<i>April 25 (Friday)</i>	Deadline for the Legislative Council to meet to review and prioritize requests from legislative members for interim studies.	108th Day

* Note: HB 13-1299 changed the deadlines in statute pertaining to the creation of interim studies and committee hearings with state departments. These deadlines have yet to be reflected in the Joint Rules of the House and Senate. This document notes only the statutory deadlines.

** All bills in the Appropriations Committee in either house on the day of the asterisked final passage deadline are excluded from the final passage deadline and from other deadlines specified in this Joint Rule until the deadlines for passing bills in the Appropriations Committee or passing bills or resolutions in the Legislative Council.
