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Standards of Review

- Confirmation of proper, current statutory authority
- Confirmation and documentation regarding the continued need for the regulation
- Determination whether the impact on small businesses and individuals can be minimized
- Quality control, i.e. are the review standards being properly and consistently applied across reviewers and programs



Standards of Review Continued

- Assessment of cost effectiveness
- Identification of duplicative, overlapping, outdated or inconsistent language or provisions
- Confirmation that the regulation is not inappropriately burdensome
- Are there viable alternatives to accomplish the purpose of the rule, i.e. agency letters, management directive, policy/procedural or guidance issued by the agency



Findings from the Review

- 8.2000 - Purpose
 - Is this section even necessary?
- 8.2001 - Definitions
 - Multiple definitions are outdated
- 8.2002.A - Data Reporting
 - References to UCR and Data Confirmation Report
 - Laundry List of data elements
 - Outdated and Overly Burdensome
