All notices received by the State pursuant to this §8.C shall be posted on the Colorado Department of Personnel & Administration's website. Knowing failure by Contractor to provide notice to the State under this §8.C shall constitute a material breach of this Contract."

Pursuant to CRS §24-102-206(1)(b), this Contractor Notification Statement shall serve as written notice to the State of Colorado (the "State") Department of Personnel & Administration that the Contractor listed below anticipates services under the above referenced Contract or any subcontract services may be performed outside the United States or the State during the term of the Contract. Services to be performed outside the United States or the State include:

Cerner intends to use Cerner associates located outside of the United States from Cerner's international offices, including but not limited to India, to assist in the build process of our electronic health record's domain due to lack of availability of U.S.-based subject matter experts.

Performance of such services outside the United States or the State are necessary or advantageous to the State for the following reasons:

Cerner will be able to complete the Future State Review during the week of January 25, 2016, if Cerner is able to use Cerner employees located internationally. Cerner needs to use such resources to maintain the contract time lines and milestone dates.
