This table shows the changes in the percentages that providers would be paid using this methodology compared to using the current methodology. For example, if Provider M would be paid 12.5% of the total funds under the current methodology, then they would be paid 12.76% of the total funds under the new methodology (12.5% + 0.26% = 12.76%). Similarly, if provider C was paid 12.5% of the total funds under the current methodology, then they would be paid 12.06% under the new methodology (12.5% - 0.44% = 12.06%).
