### Amended Emergency Regulation 44-20-102(22)-E:

DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE Motor Vehicle Dealer Board  
DEALING IN MOTOR VEHICLES 1 CCR 205-1

**Statutory Authority:** Colorado Revised Statutes, Sections 44-20-101, 44-20-102, 44-20-103, 44-20-104(3)(a), 44-20-108, and 44-20-120.

**Basis and Purpose:** To provide the ability to conduct motor vehicle sales during the COVID-19 pandemic while complying with Executive Order D 2020 044 dated April 26, 2020, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's Public Health Order 20-28 dated April 26, 2020, and other guidance issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

### Emergency Regulation 44-20-102(22)-E: ~~Online—Motor Vehicle~~ Transactions ~~and In-person Interactions~~ During COVID-19 Pandemic

During the effective period of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's Public Health Order 20-~~2428~~, ~~most recently updated March 27~~ dated April 26, 2020, licensed dealers may complete sales transactions under the conditions and in the manner described below:

- a. Dealerships shall comply with the provisions of Public Health Order 20-28 (including all appendixes), unless the local county in which a specific dealer location is located has received a variance from the State as provided under Section V of Colorado Public Health Order 20-28.
- b. Dealerships shall comply with any public health standards and orders issued by a county or municipality in which each dealership location is located.

~~Dealership sales departments and showrooms will not be open to the general public. Dealers may conduct transactions online, in their licensed location by appointment only, or remotely, provided that the Social Distancing Requirements, as defined in Section III.F of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24, are strictly adhered to.~~

~~Deliveries and in-person interactions may only be conducted in the following settings:~~

~~Outside on dealership property provided that the Social Distancing Requirements, as defined in Section III.F of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24, are strictly adhered to,  
In a service bay cleaned in accordance with the requirements for critical businesses provided in Section III.C of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24,  
In a designated room at the dealership which has been cleaned in accordance with the requirements for critical businesses provided in Section III.C of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24, or  
At the customer's residence or place of business provided that the Social Distancing Requirements, as defined in Section III.F of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24, are strictly adhered to.~~

~~C.~~—As used in this emergency regulation, “dealers” refers to either licensed motor vehicle dealers or licensed used motor vehicle dealers.

The Board hereby incorporates as part of Emergency Regulation 44-20-102(22)-E of the Colorado Motor Vehicle Dealer Board rules under 1 C.C.R. 205-1 the following public health order by reference:
