



## Colorado Road and Community Safety Act (CO-RCSA SB251)

C.R.S 42-2-501-510

*Driver's License and Identification Cards for residents who cannot demonstrate lawful presence in the U.S. and individuals who can demonstrate temporary lawful presence in the U.S.*

## **Fees for Senate Bill 13-251 Driver's License and Identification Cards (ID)**

### **Driver's License Fee\***

The total\* fee for a **driver's license** document issued under this program is **\$50.50** (\$21.00 [statutory fee] + \$29.50 [additional fee]) - The fees will be set by rule. The DMV will issue this as an emergency rule initially, and then will follow up with a formal rulemaking process.

### **Identification Card (ID) Fee**

**ID card** issued under this program is **\$14.00** (\$10.50 [statutory fee] + \$3.50 [additional fee]). - The fees will be set by rule. The DMV will issue this as an emergency rule initially, and then will follow up with a formal rulemaking process.

Note: \*If an individual has never had a driver's license or has a driver's license that has been expired for more than a year, they must first obtain an Instruction Permit as required by C.R.S. 42-2-107(1)(a)(II) for the statutory fee of \$14.00.
