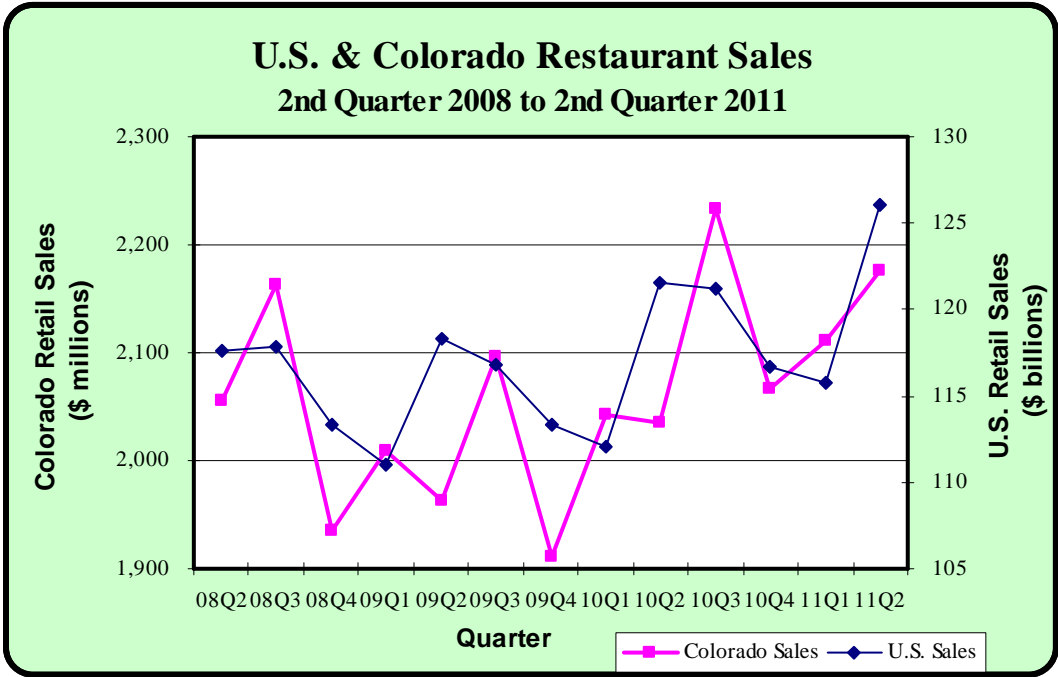
Colorado Restaurant Sales
Selected Counties

Second Quarter 2011

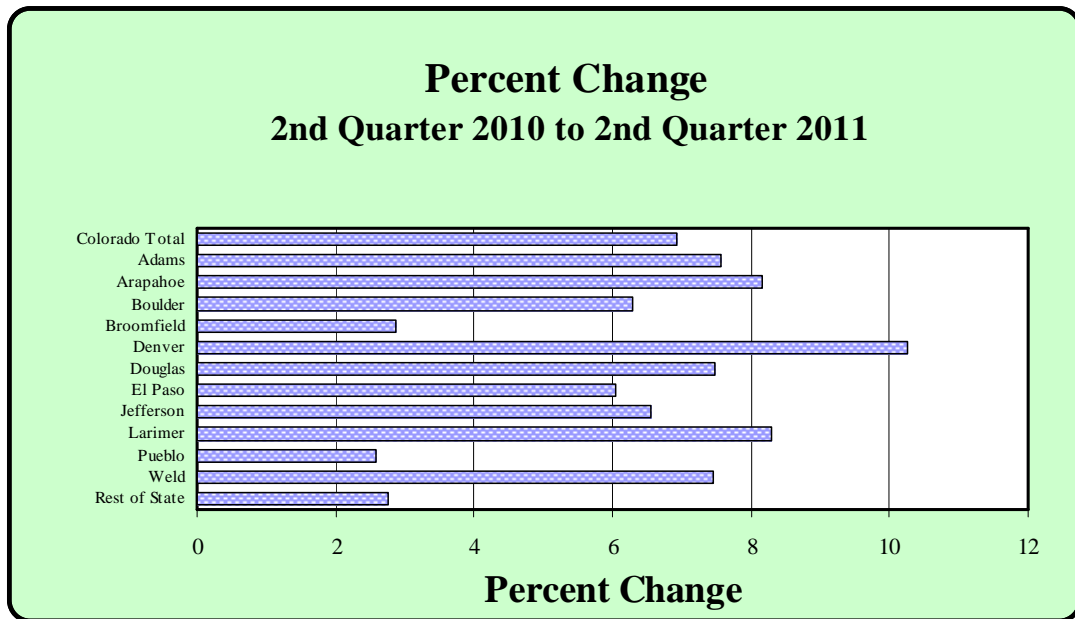
This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the second quarter 2011. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premises consumption.

Colorado restaurant industry sales in the second quarter 2011 increased 6.9 percent, to about \$2.18 billion, over the second quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 3.7 percent, to \$126 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, all of the counties showed positive growth with Denver County leading with a 10.3% increase. Pueblo County had the lowest increase of only 2.6% while the rest of the counties in the state had a combined increase of 2.8%.
