Attention City of Creede and Creede Community Foundation:

I wanted to reach out to you with regard to the new sign at the intersection of Highway 149 and Main Street Creede. I am unsure why either of your organizations would specifically slight the Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Information Center but it has been done.

The Chamber was notified by the new owners of the property, at the same intersection, that the directional sign that was located there was to be moved. The chamber did just that, they removed the sign. The chamber did this with intentional respect for the new owners and their rights. The obligation of the old owners should not pass along to the new owners in this case.

To hear of a new sign with the basic same content being placed at the site by the City and CCF without any consideration for the Chamber/Visitor Center was saddening. But to see the Chamber and Visitor Center was not mentioned at all on the sign was disappointing. The Chamber and Visitor Center is a vital part of the tourism of Creede and Mineral County and has been for many years. So vital to the area that over 120 businesses are members and believe in everything the Center does throughout the year! The Chamber and Visitor Center spend over \$45,000 each year marketing the area (including the Visitor Guide) and choose to maintain open doors seven days a week in the summer and six in the winter. Phone calls and emails are answered every day for the convenience of our locals and visitors. The Chamber and Visitor Center serve the area, but it feels as though the City and CCF are undermining those efforts.

I've attached information received for an application last spring as requested by the applicant. At the 6/2/15 meeting, Council developed a plan with the applicant as described in the above approval. Once it was approved, I didn't hear from the applicant again about the permit, nor did I receive an application fee or proof of insurance.

The group has been holding a Farmer's Market in Creede Haven and my understanding is that they are requesting to move it to Basham Park on Fridays for the remainder of the summer.

Please note that the park is unavailable August 25 - 29 for the Headwaters Music Festival. There is also an informal but very popular baseball game Friday nights. I believe they play at 6 p.m., so we may want to ask the applicant to be sure and coordinate with them.
