

8.125.10 RE-VALIDATION

- 8.125.10.A. Providers were enrolled in Medicaid on or before September 15, 2015, must complete all requirements for revalidation on a schedule established by the Department. Providers who are enrolled in Medicaid as of July 1, 2015, must re-validate before March 31, 2016, and at least every five years thereafter on a schedule as established by the Department. The revalidation schedule is available on the Department's provider webpage under "Revalidation Wave Schedule."
- 8.125.10.B. All Providers who enroll in Medicaid after July 1, 2015, must complete the requirements for re-validation one at least every five years thereafter from the date of enrollment or last revalidation.
- 8.125.10.C. A provider shall comply with all requirements for Re-validation by the dates in Sections 8.125.10.A or 8.125.10.B. If a provider fails to comply with any requirement for re-validation by the dates specified in Sections sections 8.125.10.A or 8.125.10.B, the provider agreement shall be suspended.
- 8.125.10.D. If a provider fails to comply with all requirements for re-validation within 30 days of the dates in deadlines established by Sections sections 8.125.10.A or 8.125.10.B, the provider agreement may be terminated. In the event that the provider agreement is terminated pursuant to this section, any claims submitted after the dates deadlines established in Sections sections 8.125.10.A or 8.125.10.B, above, are not reimbursable beginning on the day after the date that the provider's revalidation application was due to the Department.
