

Affordable Care Act: Colorado Update as of April 14, 2014

- More than 124,000 Coloradans signed up for private health care through Connect for Health Colorado
- 59% of the individuals who enrolled in private insurance through the marketplace received financial assistance.
- The three counties with the highest percentage of residents who signed up for coverage were Arapahoe (17.3%), Denver (17.3%), and Jefferson (15.3%).

Colorado Medicaid Expansion as of April 16, 2014

- Between October 1 and April 15, there were 178,508 individuals enrolled in Medicaid due to the expansion
 - 22,700 of those were children enrolled in either Medicaid or CHP+
- During that same time period, there were 299,809 total new applications for Medicaid/CHP+
- The three counties with the highest percentage of residents who qualified and signed up for Medicaid were Denver (18.5%), El Paso (11.8%) and Arapahoe (10.6%).
