# Objectives

1. Join physical and behavioral health under one accountable entity
2. Strengthen coordination of services by advancing team-based care and health neighborhoods
3. Promote member choice and engagement
4. Pay providers for the increased value they deliver
5. Ensure greater accountability and transparency

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# *Terminology*

## **Behavioral Health**



- Level of psychological well-being
- Both Mental Health and Substance Use

# *Policy Objectives*

- Increase access to behavioral health
- Offer interventions for non-covered diagnoses
- Provide early intervention
- Increase member options on where to receive care



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# *Short-term Behavioral Health Policy*

## Does Not:

Add New Codes

Include Health and Behavior Codes

Solve Integrated Care

## Does:

Loosen Covered Diagnosis Requirements

Increase Access

Increase Member Options

# *Short-term Behavioral Health Policy*

6 sessions within 12 months without a covered diagnosis

- Must meet medical necessity
- Must be provided by Medicaid enrolled, masters-level or higher licensed behavioral health provider
- Must follow CPT coding practices
- Must follow documentation requirements
- Available in primary care or behavioral health setting

Procedure Code	Description
90791	Diagnostic Evaluation without Medical Services
90792	Diagnostic Evaluation with Medical Services
90832	Psychotherapy—30 minutes
90834	Psychotherapy—45 minutes
90837	Psychotherapy—60 minutes
90846	Family Psychotherapy (without patient)
90847	Family Psychotherapy (with patient)


