# *Behavioral Health Goals*

- Increase access to behavioral health services
- Reduce barriers to care
- Create flexibility to pay for integrated behavioral health services within primary care settings



# *Behavioral Health Capitation*

- Retain full continuum of services
  - Current 1915(b)(3) alternative services
  - IMD “in lieu of” services
- Limit covered diagnosis requirements where possible
- Covered diagnosis will continue to be required for:
  - Inpatient hospitalizations
  - Emergency Department
  - Laboratory Tests



# *In Addition...*

- Integrated Care
  - Defining a new set of services
  - Designed for behavioral health providers working as members of primary care teams
- Primary Care-based Behavioral Health Treatment
  - Traditional billable behavioral health treatment
  - Reimbursement  $\leq X\#$  sessions
