		<b>Depression Projects – Increase depression screening and follow-up</b>
2 (NE CO)	Colorado Access – Northern Colorado Health Alliance  Carrie Bandell	Increase depression screening for adult Medicaid clients through primary care screening, use of community outreach workers and consults with psychiatry.
2 (NE CO)	Colorado Access – Salud Family Health Centers  Carrie Bandell	Patient Portal Access Project - Salud clinics will implement screening for depression in waiting rooms and the results will display in exam room EHR. Treating provider will review and provide necessary follow-up.
3 (East Metro)	Colorado Access – MCPN  Carrie Bandell	Integrating primary care with mental health and substance abuse services through utilization of care coordinators providing home visits and increased training for care coordinators regarding screening and interventions for MH/SA.
4 (SE CO)	Integrated Community Health Partners, LLC  Donna Mills	Medical Neighborhood Block Party to improve provider collaboration and education and training regarding screening for depression in primary care practices.

Create an electronic version of the tools in English and in Spanish. Incorporate the tools into the electronic health record to ensure patient population is screened for depression.

1 (Western CO)	Rocky Mountain Health Health Plans, Inc.  Jenny Nate	Implement utilization of electronic patient activation measure tool in practices throughout region to improve medication adherence and self care strategies for managing chronic conditions.
2 (NE CO)	Colorado Access – Northern Colorado Health Alliance  Carrie Bandell	Increase the percentage of adult Medicaid clients with a diagnosis of major depression whose antidepressant medication is prescribed and taken to achieve maximum effectiveness. (Being done in conjunction with increasing depression screening)

2 (NE CO)	Colorado Access – Salud Family Health Centers  Carrie Bandell	Salud clinics will use the Patient Portal as a method to notify patients with diabetes to come to the clinic for their annual HgbA1c lab test.
3 (East Metro)	Colorado Access  Carrie Bandell	Barrier analysis on implementation of the CDSMP (Chronic Disease Self-Management Program) model for Medicaid adults diagnosed with diabetes. Targeting individuals diagnosed with diabetes and providing incentives for completion of CDSMP course.
4 (SE CO)	Integrated Community Health Partners, LLC  Donna Mills	Create a cross-organizational data sharing system to alert providers regarding members diagnosed with diabetes and need for hemoglobin A1C test.
6 (NW Metro)	Colorado Community Health Alliance  Zula Solomon Brandi Nottingham	Develop and implement a diabetes group visit program within practices for high risk individuals diagnosed with diabetes that have been hospitalized for diabetes related conditions or visited the ER for diabetes related conditions.
