



Air Pollutant Emission Notice (APEN)/Permit Exempt Checklist

This is a form for sources to determine APEN/Permit Exempt status for select source categories as part of a pilot project. Please check AQCC Regulation No. 3 at:

www.colorado.gov/cdphe/aqcc-regs for other APEN and Permit Exempt categories if you wish to use the write-in boxes below. *Note that you may be APEN exempt based on 'de minimus' emissions, please check Regulation No. 3 Part A Section II.D before using this checklist.*

Is your source one of the following?

APEN Exempt/Permit Exempt:

- Paint booths or auto body shops with emissions less than 1 ton/year for all criteria pollutants in ozone nonattainment area (Larimer, Weld, Boulder, Adams, Arapahoe, Jefferson, Denver, Broomfield, Douglas counties) and less than 2 tons/year for all other counties
- A heater or boiler with a design capacity less than or equal to 5 MMBtu/hour that is fueled solely by natural gas or liquid petroleum gas (LPG)
- A heater or boiler with a design capacity less than or equal to 10 MMBtu/hour *used solely for heating buildings for personal comfort* that is fueled solely by natural gas or liquid petroleum gas (LPG)
- Storage tank(s) of capacity less than 40,000 gallons of (used or new) lubricating oils
- Wet screening operations NOT subject to NSPS OOO requirements
- Surface area disturbance for purposes of land development that are less than 25 acres AND less than 6 months in duration
- Other: _____

If APEN exempt, do not submit any information. You are exempt from APEN and Permit Requirements. If you want an APEN exempt letter, see website link below.

APEN Required/Permit Exempt:

- Stationary internal combustion engine that is an emergency power generator that operates no more than 250 hrs/year
- Stationary internal combustion engine with uncontrolled actual emissions less than 5 tons per year for each individual criteria pollutant emitted
- Stationary internal combustion engine with manufacturer's site-rated horsepower of less than 50
- A heater or boiler with a design capacity less than or equal to 10 MMBtu/hour that is fueled solely by natural gas or liquid petroleum gas (LPG) (which is not APEN Exempt/Permit Exempt as stated above)
- Gasoline station located in an ozone attainment area (Any county EXCEPT the following: Douglas, Jefferson, Broomfield, Boulder, Larimer, Weld, Adams, Arapahoe, and Denver)
- Other: _____
