On March 17th and June 23rd, 2016, the Air Pollution Control Division ("Division") held public stakeholder meetings related to the Denver Metro/North Front Range 8-Hour Ozone Nonattainment Area being "bumped up" from a marginal to moderate classification. At these meetings, Division staff discussed proposed revisions to the Air Quality Control Commission's ("Commission's") Regulations 3, 7, and 11 as well as the Commission's Air Quality Standards, Designations and Emission Budgets. This meeting will only focus on certain portions of the proposed revisions to Regulation 7.

This meeting is available to all stakeholders, to discuss concerns raised about identifying specific Reasonably Available Control Technology ("RACT") requirements in Colorado's Ozone State Implementation Plan. At this meeting, the Division will discuss concerns raised about the proposed RACT rule language. The Division will identify revisions made in response to comments received to date, and continue exploring options to address those concerns. Due to space limitations, we kindly ask that you limit attendance to 2 persons per organization invited and register to attend the meeting in advance. This meeting will also be webcast.
