WHO MUST APPLY:

All firms that wish to perform lead-based paint activities in the State of Colorado. Certification is required under Colorado law (25-7-1101 et seq., C.R.S.). Companies must certify that their employees performing lead-based paint activities have been trained in accordance with Colorado laws and AQCC Regulation No. 19, and have attended refresher training as required.

Certification is valid for one year. Please refer to the table on the reverse for fee amount. Applications submitted without the fee will be returned to the applicant. **Please make checks or money orders payable to Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, or simply "CDPHE". DO NOT SEND CASH.**
