RE: Tribal Notification re Operating and PSD Permits

We recently received a request from the Southern Ute Indian Tribe (located near Durango) to send them copies of PSD and Operating Permit public notices for any sources located within 50 miles of their reservation. We responded to them in an October 7 letter (attached) and made a commitment to send them the copies that they requested.

We do not expect that there will be a lot of sources that will need this special attention. There are no PSD sources planned for that area that we are aware of. In terms of Operating Permits, we think that there might be half a dozen sources located within the 50 mile limit. We will try to flag the sources during the permit review process.
