## Colorado county government air-quality contacts for smoke

### Relevance

1. Two to 48 hours before a person who has a smoke management permit ignites a prescribed fire in Colorado, they must notify the person listed below for the county in which they are burning.
2. The State of Colorado has delegated to some counties authority to issue [open burning smoke permits](#). If the county has delegated authority, the **county's name is in bold and is highlighted** in the list below. If the county's name is not in bold and highlighted, smoke permits for open burning in that county are issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Unlike open burn smoke permits, all [smoke management permits](#) are issued by the state.
