Joni Canterbury, SBAP provided an overview of the Air Pollution Control Division Health and Safety Program that is under development with the goal of being a one-stop safety shop. CAP members wanted to know if the services would be available for small business.

Completed old business

- Approved minutes from September 20, 2012 meeting, with one change to the location of the Hazardous Materials Waste Management Division training sites, Durango should be Denver, S. Bush moved, T. Thwaites second, no discussion, all aye to accept.

Committee Reports

Ben Greene/CAP-NCAP- Not much to report. Send Sustainability webinar info to CAP members.

Tom Thwaites/CAP – Coda Coffee interest in obtaining B-Corp status, info from T. Dunn/CAP.

Elizabeth Sapio/SBO- Discussed possibility of writing up a small business for the SBO/SBEAP Annual meeting in Chicago. No one from the state will be attending, however, some of the sessions including a CAP training are available by webinar, details to follow.

Christine Hoefler/SBAP- Changes to Regulation No. 6 (state only New Source Performance Standard), if companies bring in equipment, it is considered “new” to CO. Stakeholder process for Oil and Gas industry. Looking to change rules- Reg. 6 and Reg 3, will affect all businesses. Possible change to limits of 25 tons/year of any pollutant before permitting is necessary. APENs would still be required. 6,400 sources may no longer need permits. The goal is to reduce the backlog of permits and focus on what is important to put in the permit to protect public health. Composting- letter out to 32 sources stating they will need to submit APENs. Demonstrated APCD web page and updates, highlighting the addition of “Hot Topics”, and “Regulatory Development Actions”.

Joni Canterbury/SBAP – Discussed the Dry Cleaner Alternatives Trade Show. Presentations scheduled to discuss remediation and transitioning to alternatives, promoting wet cleaning. Thirty-six vendors scheduled to attend. Shared the promotional flyer with the CAP and requested assistance the day of the event.
