Model Specifications For Breath Alcohol Ignition Interlock
Devices (BAIIDs)

The approval of a Breath Alcohol Ignition Interlock Devices (BAIIDs) by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) will be based on completion of the following requirements:

1. The Manufacturer or Distributor of the Breath Alcohol Ignition Interlock Device (BAIID) must submit the following documents to the CDPHE Evidential Breath Alcohol Testing (EBAT) Program when seeking approval of a specific BAIID model
These documents must include:
 - a. A written request from the manufacturer seeking approval for a specific BAIID model.
 - b. A notarized affidavit from the ISO-Accredited laboratory attesting that the specific BAIID model meets or exceeds the current NHTSA BAIID Model Specifications.
 - c. A copy of the ISO-Accredited laboratory test results for the BAIID model tested.
2. The CDPHE Evidential Breath Alcohol Testing (EBAT) Program personnel will review, evaluate and verify the information provided.
3. Upon completion of the documentation review, EBAT Program personnel will make a recommendation for approval or denial of approval of the specific BAIID model to the CDPHE Executive Director or designee.
4. The manufacturer or distributor will be notified in writing of the Department's approval decision.
5. Approved Devices will be placed on the List of Approved BAIID Models and published on the Department's website at www.coloradoebat.us for distribution.
