

Phillips County Commissioner Meeting
August 07, 2012

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Chairman Joe Kinnie and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Commissioners Joe Kinnie, Jerry Beavers and Bud Bieseemeier and County Clerk Beth Zilla.

Those present at the meeting were Commissioner candidates for District Three, Carl Wirth and Don Lock, and Commissioner candidate for District Two, Harlan Stern.

The board met with Rick Unrein and Matt Muesborn from Grainland coop. They would like to have CDL testing in the county again. Matt has to be employed as a government employee in order to fill the requirements to obtain a government license versus a private license. They are asking the board if they would consider employing Matt in order to meet the requirements. Grainland has an agreement with Highline Association to use their parking lot facility for the drive test. The board will do some research on hiring Matt and will meet with Rick and Matt at next meeting to finalize paperwork.

Bud Bieseemeier made a motion to approve the hiring of Edwin Race as a District #1 road worker contingent upon a negative CDOT pre-employment screening test. Edwin will start on RB Grade 16 Step 3, \$26,254.54 per year, \$2,187.88 per month, and \$12.62 per hour beginning August 03, 2012. Edwin will be eligible for a Step increase in 6 month contingent on a positive performance appraisal. Jerry Beavers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jerry Beavers made a motion to approve the hiring of Evan Consalvos as District #1 Foreman contingent upon a negative CDOT pre-employment screening test. Evan will start on RB Grade 22 Step 4, \$31,360.64 per year, \$2,613.39 per month and \$15.08 per hour beginning August 03, 2012. Evan will be eligible for a step increase in 6 months contingent on a positive performance appraisal. Bud Bieseemeier seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Bud Bieseemeier made a motion to approve the hiring of Daniel Waln as a part-time maintenance worker. Daniel will be working at an hourly rate of \$11.00/ hour effective August 01, 2012 through September 14, 2012. Jerry Beaver seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The board met with Landfill Manager Bill Andrews. The town of Haxtun and L&L Ready Mix have agreed to have Killion Enterprises, LLC grind their concrete. Bill would like them to grind the landfill's concrete also.

Jerry Beavers made a motion to have the chairman sign the contract with Killion Enterprises, LLC to grind the concrete at the landfill at the cost of \$7.50 per ton. Bud Bieseemeier seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The board met with Courthouse Maintenance Supervisor Garold Roberts. Garold presented the board with a list of Fair-time Responsibilities. Garold has also an "ON CALL" schedule for the Event Center.

The board met with County Treasurer Linda Statz. Linda asked for the board approval to reimburse Jack Dalton for a tax sale on a mobile home that is no longer on the property. The amount of the reimbursement will be approximately \$500.00. The board agreed to allow the reimbursement.

Jerry Beavers made a motion to become the Board of Social Services at 1:00. Bud Bieseemeier seconded the motion. Motion carried. The minutes from this portion of the meeting are maintained by the Department of Social Services.

Jerry Beavers made a motion to approve the July 31, 2012 minutes. Bud Bieseemeier seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
