

West Creek.

(32nd)—That the ditches taking water from West Creek are entitled to West Creek priorities as follows to-wit:

- No. 1—The Oakmot Ditch, original construction May 31, 1873.
- No. 2—The Cottonwood Ditch, original construction April 29, 1876.
- No. 3—The Hillside Ditch, original construction June 30, 1885.
- No. 4—The Cottonwood Ditch, enlargement December 30, 1887.
- No. 5—The West Ditch, original construction June 30, 1889.

Hamilton Creek.

(33d)—That the ditches taking water from Hamilton Creek are entitled to Hamilton Creek priorities as follows, to-wit:

- No. 1—The Hamilton Creek Ditch, original construction May 31, 1874.
- No. 2—The Hamilton Creek Ditch, increased appropriation October 31, 1879.
- No. 3—The Cramlet Ditch, original construction August 31, 1889.

Barnard Creek.

(34th)—That the ditches taking water from Barnard Creek are entitled to Barnard Creek priorities as follows:

- No. 1—The Hylton Ditch, original construction May 31, 1871.
- No. 2—The Barnard Ditch, original construction May 31, 1872.
- No. 3—The Gross & Witcher Ditch, original appropriation December 30, 1873.
- No. 4—The Gross & Witcher Ditch, original construction May 31, 1877.
- No. 5—The Gross & Witcher Ditch, increased appropriation December 30, 1882.
- No. 6—The Barnard Creek Ditch, original construction April 1, 1884.

Cottonwood Creek.

The one flowing directly in the Arkansas.

(35th)—That the ditches taking water from Cottonwood Creek (which said creek flows directly into the river) are entitled to Cottonwood Creek priorities as follows:

- No. 1—The John Baker Ditch, original construction April 1, 1874.
- No. 2—The Mosier Ditch, original construction December 30, 1878.
- No. 3—The Little Cottonwood Ditch, original construction May 14, 1880.
- No. 4—The John Baker Ditch, 1st enlargement April 10, 1886.
- No. 5—The John Baker Ditch, 2nd enlargement April 1, 1889.
