Town of Bennett Awards Recipients of Bennett Gives Back Grant

Town of Bennett, Colo. – The Town of Bennett announced the recipients of the Bennett Gives Back Grant on Wednesday June 13, 2018.

The 2018 Bennett Gives Back Grant was awarded to the Arapahoe County 4-H Shooting Sports, the Bennett FFA Chapter, the Tri-Valley VFW Post #8449, the Bennett Wrestling Club, the Bennett Imagination Library and the Court Appointed Special Advocates of Adams County.

The Town of Bennett Board of Trustees and Bennett Gives Back Advisory Board approved grant funding for the following projects:

- Arapahoe County 4-H Shooting Sports, New Storage Trailer; \$3,275 total grant funding
- Bennett FFA Chapter School, Farm/Water Tap; \$10,000 total grant funding
- Tri-Valley VFW Post #8449, Upgrade and replace the HVAC; \$8,000 total grant funding
- Bennett Wrestling Club, new singlets; \$4,325 total grant funding
- Bennett Imagination Library, providing a monthly free book to children under the age of five; \$2,900 total grant funding
- CASA of Adams County; \$1,500 total grant funding

Recipients of the Bennett Gives Back Grant will be recognized at the Town Board Meeting on Tuesday June 26, 2018 at 7 p.m.

The Town of Bennett, through the Bennett Gives Back Grant (BGB Grant), may provide a grant up to 90% of the costs of a qualifying event, project, program or activity in an amount up to \$10,000 per organization per year from the Town's general fund. The purpose of the program is for eligible organizations and special districts to obtain additional resources to help supplement services or resources provided to the residents of Bennett.

Awarded funds were distributed on Board discretion and project limits. The 2018 Grant Cycle total funding allocation is \$30,000.
