BILL TOPIC: TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE PROCEDURES

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, the Statewide Transportation Advisory Committee (STAC) provides advice to the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) on the needs of transportation systems and reviews and comments on all regional transportation plans. This bill, **requested by the Transportation Legislation Review Committee**, requires the STAC to provide advice and comments to both CDOT and the Transportation Commission, rather than only to CDOT. The bill also specifies that the STAC will provide advice on budgets and transportation policy, programming, and planning.

Background

The 11-member Transportation Commission formulates general policy, prescribes administrative practices, and makes all reasonable rules and regulations needed to carry out transportation programs. It also makes recommendations to CDOT, the Governor, and the General Assembly related to the state transportation system.

Assessment

The bill does not change revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 10, 2016, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 11, 2016, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
