



Enrollment Types

Billing Individual vs Individual in a Group

Income from Colorado Medicaid is reported to the IRS under the **Individual's SSN**

Individual is **both** a billing provider and a rendering provider

Does **not** need to be associated to a Group

Must
Complete application using the individual's SSN (for screening purposes)

Income from Colorado Medicaid is reported to the IRS under the appropriate **Group's EIN**

Rendering provider **only** (Group is the billing provider)

Must be associated to one or more Group(s)

What if I'm an Individual, but I want to use my EIN for enrollment?

Even if you are the only practitioner or individual - If you want your income from Colorado Medicaid to be reported to the IRS under your EIN, you will need to complete an application using the Group enrollment type. Use your EIN as the Tax ID type on this group application.

After you submit an application for your Group, you will also need to submit an application using the Individual within a Group enrollment type.

On the Request Information page of the Individual within a Group application, you will indicate that you are affiliated to your Group by completing the Group Association section. Use your SSN as the Tax ID type on this Individual within a Group application.

This will allow you to bill under your business EIN, and render services under your SSN.
