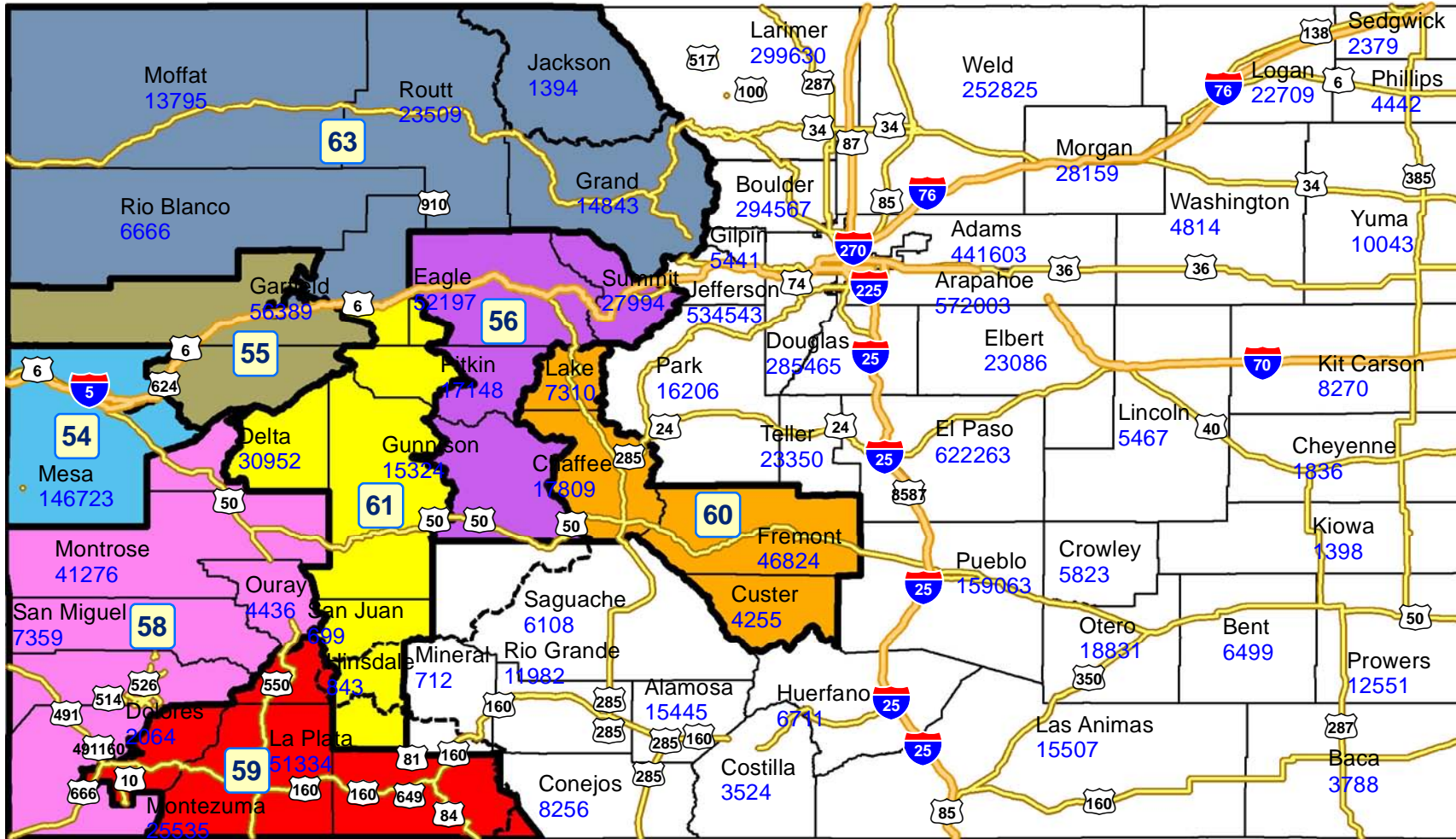


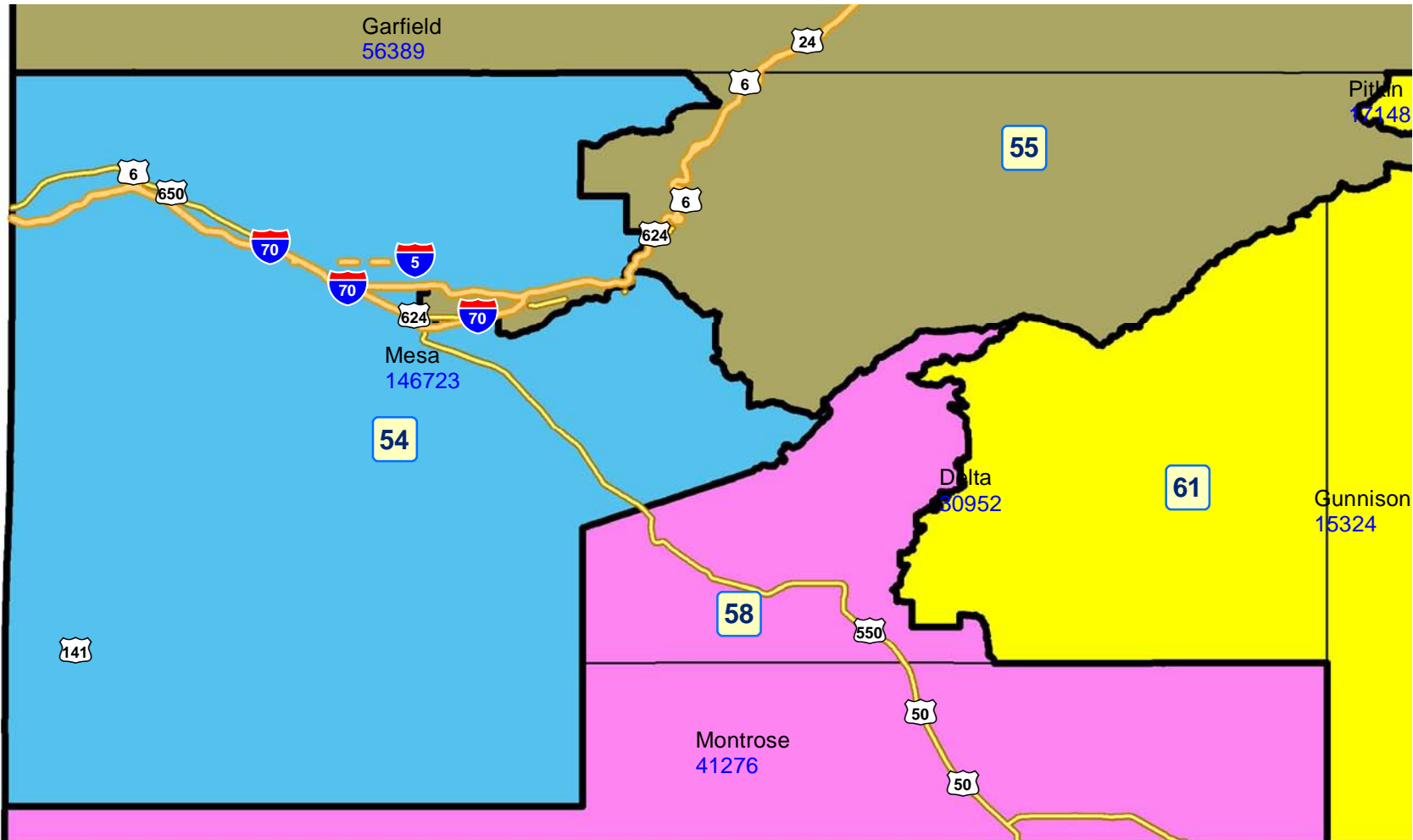

Berry Western Slope Proposal Option 1 (Mesa and Delta Counties Zoom)

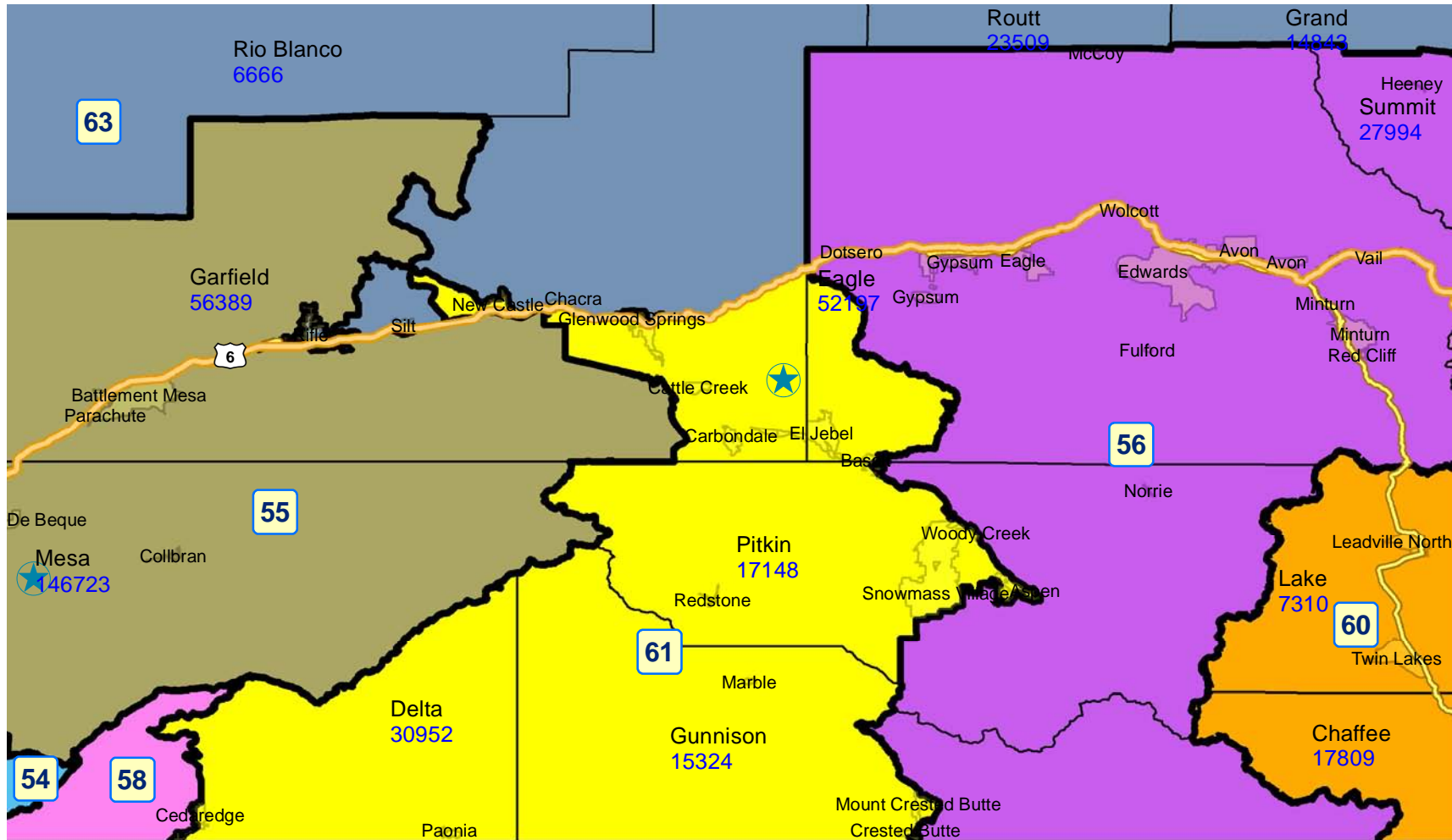

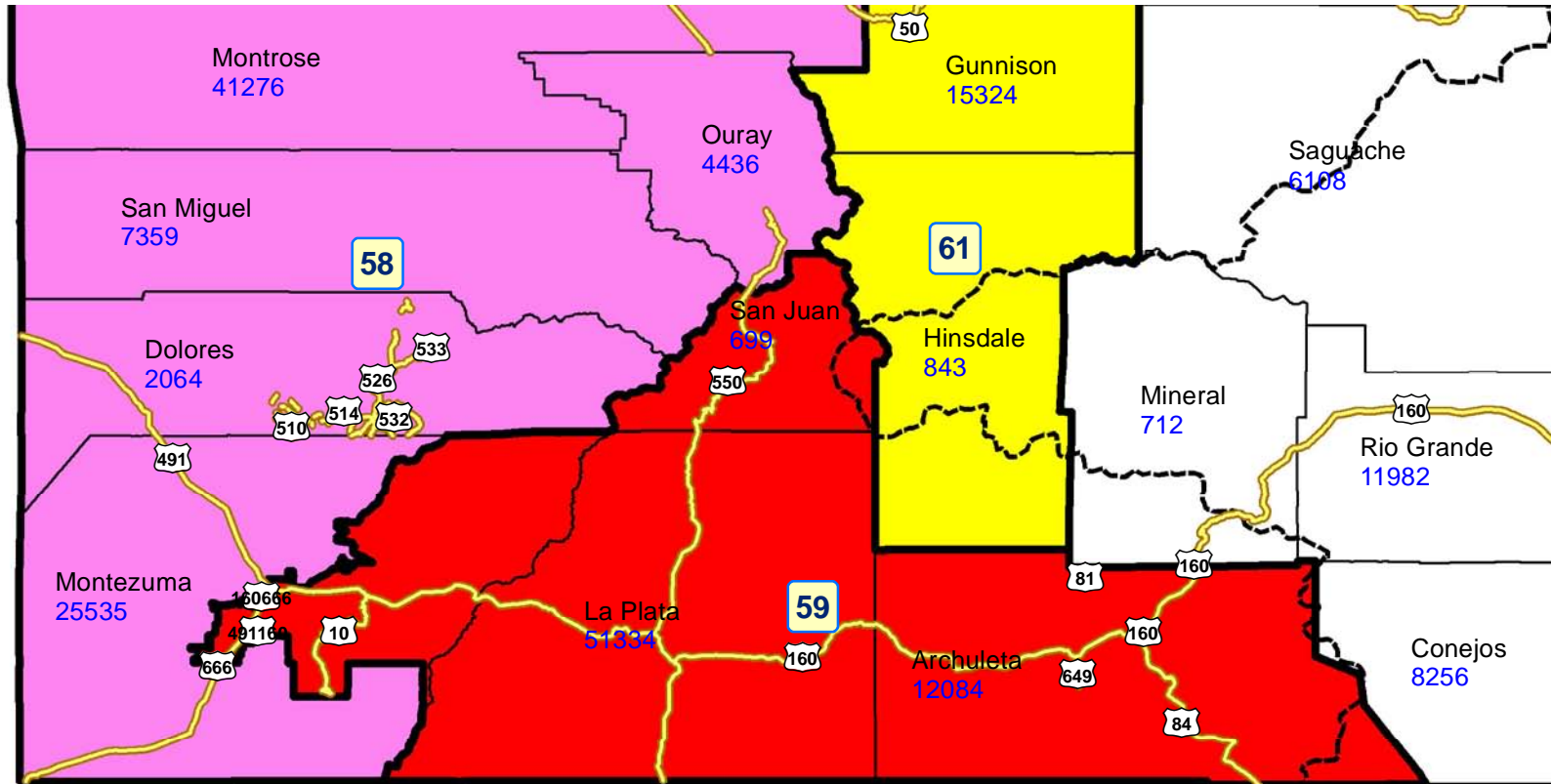
Berry Western Slope Proposal Option 1 (Roaring Fork Valley Zoom)
