Winter is Coming!

It's the end of October, the first snow has fallen, snow making has started and that means winter is coming. The Town of Blue River has once again contracted with Highland Galloway Investments to handle the snow plowing of all Town roads. As you prep your home for winter, please take time to do some additional preparation for snow removal.



Please take time to mark any landscaping that may be close to the road or in the snow removal zone. Use markings that will be visible throughout the winter. This will assist snow removal crews in knowing where your landscaping is located to avoid possible damage. Keep in mind that crews are often plowing while it is still dark out.

Snow Removal Operations

Snow Removal operations will begin on November 1st. Our snow plow contractor has added additional equipment to assist with the operations this year. Per the snow removal contract, snow will be removed from all town roads when there are 4" of accumulation from the previous plowing.

The official measurement will be at Town Hall. The determination for plowing will be made between 1 a.m.-3 p.m.



If you hire a snow removal company to remove snow from your driveway, please note that they do need to have a Blue River Business License. Additionally, it is against Town Code for snow to be pushed across the road. Violations will be issued accordingly.

There is no parking allowed on Town roads. To ensure snow removal equipment can effectively remove snow from Town roads, please adhere to this code.

Building In Blue River

In the Town of Blue River, permits are needed for a variety of items. These include: building permits; staining and re-staining; sheds; landscaping; roofs; interior construction; electrical; and tree removal to name a few.

Applications are available at Town Hall and online. BEFORE doing any construction or improvements to your home and property check to make sure whether or not a permit is required. In many cases approval is also necessary from the Planning and Zoning Commission. Fees for permits vary based on work being performed.


In addition to permits, any contractor working on your property in the Town of Blue River is required to obtain a Business License. The fee is \$50/year.

If you are adding on to your home, adding bedrooms, bathrooms, a hot tub, etc. It is necessary for you to verify your water rights, sewer or septic permits. Before construction, take time to ensure you have all the property water/sewer/septic permits in place.
