Brew Pub Liquor License

A "Brew Pub" license allows:

- sales of malt, vinous, and spirituous liquor for consumption on the premises
- manufacture of up to 1,860,000 gallons of malt liquor annually on its premises

Malt liquor manufactured on the premises may be:

- sold and consumed on the premises
- sold to the public in sealed containers for consumption off the premises
- sold at wholesale to retailers in an amount up to 300,000 gallons per calendar year
- sold to independent wholesalers for distribution to retailers

On premises | A brew pub may sell malt, vinous and spirituous liquors in the place where they are to be consumed from 7:00AM to 2:00AM every day of the week.

Brew Pubs are required to sell food as a part of their on-premises business operation. Food sales must constitute 15% of the gross on-premises food and drink income of the brew pub. "Food" by statute means a quantity of foodstuff of such nature as is ordinarily consumed by an individual at regular intervals for the purpose of sustenance.

Off- premises | Brew pubs may sell only malt liquor of their own manufacture in sealed containers for off-premises consumption, from 8:00AM to midnight, Monday through Sunday. No off-premises sales are allowed on Christmas.
