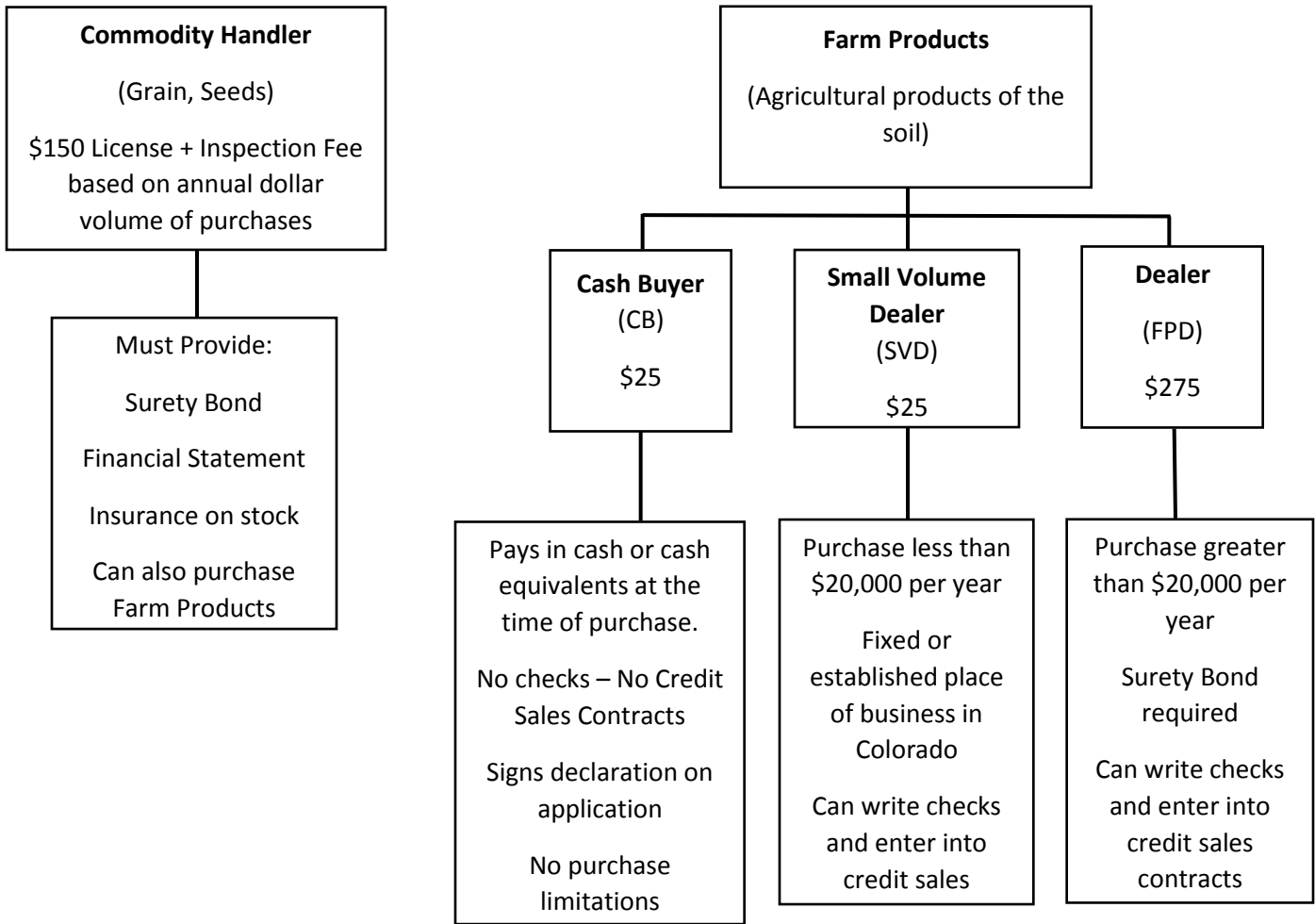




Farm Products License or Commodity Handler?



What is a **farm product**? – **Unprocessed** agricultural, horticultural, viticultural, fruit, vegetable products of the soil to include: Livestock – not resold or processed within 90 days, milk, honey, ensiled corn, baled, cubed or ground hay, and industrial hemp

What is a **commodity**? – **Unprocessed** small hard seeds or fruits such as wheat, corn, oats, barley, rye, sunflower seeds, soybeans, beans, grain sorghum, and industrial hemp

What is a **credit sales contract**? – all commodities and farm products must be paid for in 30 days, if payment is going to be made after 30 days, transaction must be on a credit sales contract
