Public safety and health concern call to action: Mandatory dispensary staff training how to detect quality product from products that should not be served to the public. **1.** Customer service training. **2.** Train dispensary staff to observe if flower product is infected with a variety of molds, insects, rot, nutrient lock, and non flushes. **Current mandatory lab tests do not detect these issues!** **3.** Train staff how to detect Indica from Sativa. **4** Train staff to advise customers about potency, effect, and how long to wait before driving between the different products. **5.** Recommendations for good parenting measures when product will be in the same house as children.

What is Hash? Different kinds of Hash.

Kief: Kief is the most basic form of hash.

Bubble: Bubble is one step up from kief. When you extract the trichomes using bags with screens on the bottom in a bucket of cold ice water.

Earwax or Wax: Wax has been extracted with a solvent, usually butane.

Shatter: Shatter is the result of over purging wax.

Budder: Budder is very similar to wax. The difference is it's wet and thus less waxy.

Hash Oil:

Hash oil is arguably the most pure form of solvent extracted hash.

Solvent free: The goal of many hash makers currently is to make a wax or shatter like product that is solvent free.
