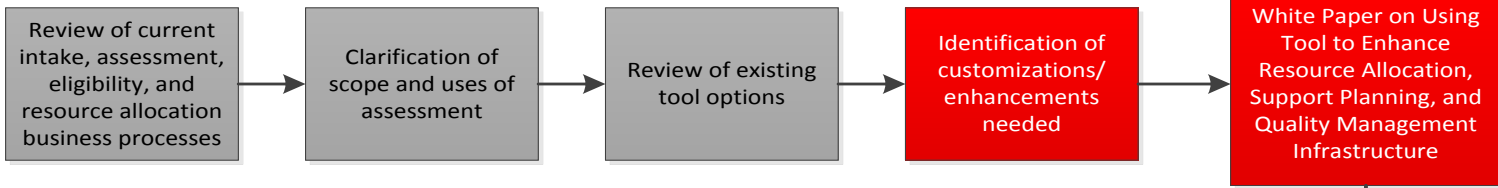

- Develop presentations and white paper on how the tools could be used to enhance further systems change



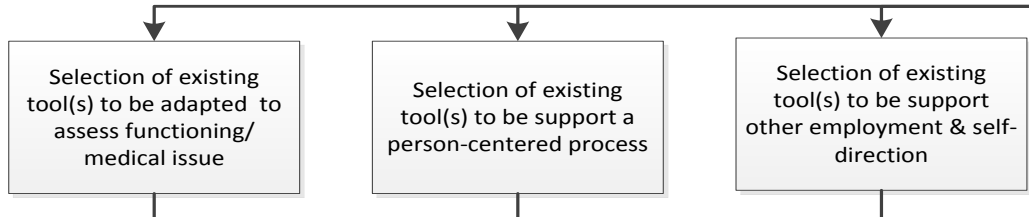

Laying the Groundwork for the New Assessment Process



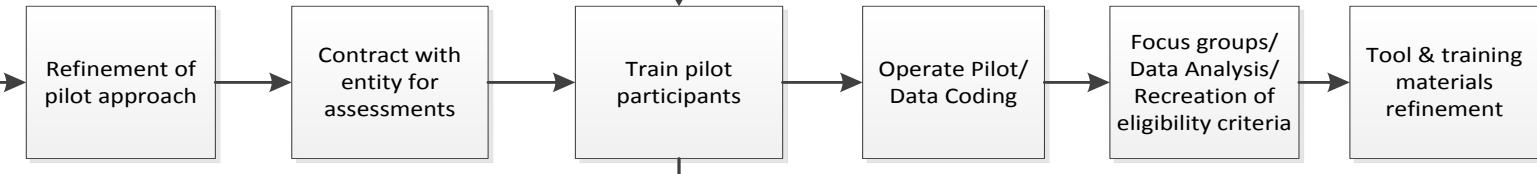
Selection of Existing Tools to be Adapted



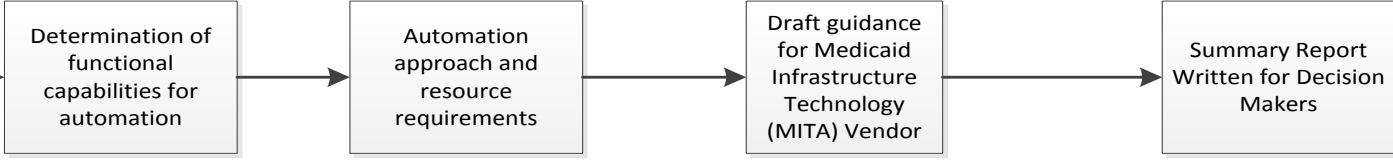

# White Paper

- Original scope envisioned laying out how the new assessment tool could be used to enhance resource allocation, support planning, and quality improvement



# New Approach to White Paper

- New approach will:
  - Clarify principles that should guide systems improvement
  - Identify the goals of the systems reform effort
  - Determine where current systems redesign efforts fit
  - Layout the major areas where the delivery of HCBS will need to change to achieve the goals
