

Waivers targeted to people with IDD

People with I/DD may also meet the targeting criteria for other waivers, so while these waivers only target people with I/DD, there is nothing that would prohibit a person with I/DD from say enrolling in the EBD waiver, if say they ALSO had a physical disability.
