Checklist and Guidelines

How to become a MOST Training Provider (Vendor)

- Identify need for training support in proposed area(s) of the state
- Establish ability to operate a business in Colorado
- Identify a suitable training site location including market research to determine viability of business model
- Establish and provide proof of legal access to a Range and Classroom Facility
- Obtain approval to utilize MOST approved curriculum from the relevant curriculum provider(s) (i.e. MSF RERP and RIF Agreements, Range Recognition Letter(s), etc.)

- Obtain fleet of appropriate Training Motorcycles that adhere to MOST rules
- Recruit and sponsor an adequate number of certified MOST Instructors
- Request an inspection of proposed Training Site by the MOST Program or its agents
- Review and execute the MOST Vendor Agreement
- Review and execute the MOST Policies and Procedures Agreement
