Colorado Ag Facts

▲ Value of all agricultural products sold in 2012 totaled \$7.8 billion, a 28% increase from 2007.

▲ Agribusiness contributes \$40 billion to the state economy each year and employs more than 170,000 people.

▲ There are more than 36,000 farms in the state encompassing nearly 32 million acres.

▲ Colorado's average farm size is 881 acres.
