**ALFALFA (Grown for Seed Purposes Only)**

For the control of the two-spotted spider mite complex.

**Ground Application:** Use 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> pints of COMITE II per acre in 20 to 40 gallons of water per acre.

**Aerial Application:** Use 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> pints of COMITE II in a minimum of 8 gallons of water per acre.

**Restricted Entry Interval:** 9 days

**NOTE:**  
The feeding of treated foliage, alfalfa trash or seed screenings to livestock and the grazing of treated fields is prohibited. All alfalfa seed grown or conditioned as a non-food or non-feed site in the state of Colorado shall bear a tag or a container label which forbids the use of seed for human consumption or animal food. It shall be the grower's responsibility to notify the processing plants of any seed crop treated with COMITE II.

No alfalfa seed grown or conditioned as a non-food or non-feed site in the state of Colorado may be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.

Treated alfalfa seed is not to be used for sprouting.

COMITE II is not hazardous to bees when used alone. However, bee hazards may be encountered when combined with other insecticides. Observe State Department of Agriculture regulations on the use of insecticides for seed alfalfa.

COMITE II is compatible with most insecticides. Check COMITE II label and information handbook for details.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA registered label.  
This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of the pesticide application.
