

Richard Nathan serves as a member from the 6th Congressional District. His term expires July 1,2023. He is an attorney with over 25 years' experience in the practice of regulatory law. He served as a prosecutor in the Colorado Attorney General's office as First Assistant Attorney General for Criminal Justice and Director of the Colorado Organized Crime Strike Force. During his years in the Attorney General's office he participated as a trainer for the National Association of Attorneys General and National College of District Attorneys on the investigation and prosecution of organized crime and political corruption cases.

After leaving government service Mr. Nathan was in private practice emphasizing litigation and regulatory compliance. A major concentration in his practice from 1992 until 2014 was on behalf of clients in the gaming industry including representation of clients before regulatory boards and commissions throughout the United States and international jurisdictions.

Mr. Nathan was an adjunct Professor of Law at the University of Denver College of Law during the years 1997 and 1998 teaching courses in Gaming Law. He obtained his undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Denver.
