Subject: PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING QMAP TRAINING
Revision to 10 CCR 2505-10, 8.603.9 pursuant to HB 16-1424

Purpose:

To inform Stakeholders of comments received during informal public comment period and to provide responses from the Department.

Background:

On July 26, 2017 the Department proposed changes to 10 CCR 2505-10, 8.603.9, concerning Personnel and Contractor Administration. Pursuant to HB16-1424, the Department proposed revisions to the regulations regarding training for Qualified Medication Administration Persons (QMAPs). Consistent with HB16-1424, QMAPs must complete a training through an Approved Training Entity, as designated the the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.

The Department accepted public comment on this rule from July 27, 2017 through August 25, 2017. During this period no comments were received. The informal public comment period is now closed. The Department will proceed with formally presenting this rule to the Medical Services Board in October 2017.

Action:

The Department will proceed with initial presentation of this rule to the Medical Services Board on October 13, 2017. Additional public comment can be made at the Public Rule Review Meeting on September 18, 2017.

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
