Purpose: Information on the application process for the Colorado Choice Transitions (CCT) Transition Coordination Services Infrastructure Development Grant Opportunity.

Background: Colorado Choice Transitions (CCT), a Money Follows the Person (MFP) initiative is a federal grant-funded program, to help transition Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) members from long-term care facilities into home and community-based settings. CCT is also aimed at finding solutions to barriers that prevent community transitions and strengthening the delivery system for home and community-based services. The Transition Coordination Services Infrastructure Development Grant is a grant opportunity designed to help achieve these goals. The grant provides funding to Transition Coordination Agencies (TCAs) to compensate for transition-related expenses not reimbursed by the Community Transition Services (CTS) service rate and to promote infrastructure development.

The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing recognizes that the provision of transition coordination services is critical to the success of CCT. The expected outcome of funding through the Transition Coordination Infrastructure Grant will be increased capacity of participating TCAs to provide transition coordination services to Health First Colorado members.
